

Ministry at OUC

Sunday School is an interactive way for kids and teens to learn the stories that are found in the Bible. Adult classes study the scripture in a deeper more applicable way. Sunday School meets Sundays at 9:00am.

Sunday Morning Worship Service is a time to focus on the Lord Jesus Christ, through song, prayer, and thought provoking messages from the Bible. The service is held in the main sanctuary on Sundays at 10:15am. **Nursery** for ages birth to 4 years old and **Children's Church** for ages 4 years through 6th grade are available during this service.

Sunday Evening Service is a casual and interactive time to learn how to apply the Bible to your life. This service meets in the Multi-Purpose room on Sundays at 6:30pm. Pastor Adam Wolfgang leads this service.

Upper Room is an interactive time for 6th through 12th Grade teens to learn from the Bible through song and scripture. This is a time for teen to learn and have fun. They meet on Mondays at 6:30pm in the youth room on the upper level of OUC.

Small Group Bible Study is open to anyone who has an interest in learning more from God's word, and how to apply it to their life.

- **Small Group Bible Study on the "Parables"** meets on Tuesdays at 6:30pm.
- **Small Group Ladies Bible Study on the book of "Job"** meets at 133 Church St, the church manse on Thursdays at 10:00am.

Kid's Klub is a fun way for ages Kindergarten through Eighth Grade to learn about the Bible through stories, games, and scripture memorization. They meet on Wednesday from 3:30pm to 5:00pm in the church's fellowship hall, on the lower level.

Prayer Meeting is a time to study the Bible and pray for other's needs and the ministries at OUC. It is on Wednesdays at 6:30pm. The study is "The Heidelberg Catechism", and it is led by Pastor Adam Wolfgang. This service meets in the Prayer Room on the east side of the Main Sanctuary.

Men's Coffee at the Rootbeer Stand is a time for men to take a break from their busy schedule to fellowship with other men from the church and community. They meet at the Rootbeer Stand on Columbia Ave. in Oglesby each Thursday at 10:00am.

Men's Breakfast meets one Saturday a month at 7:30am. During this fellowship time men receive Bible based teaching on manhood and common issues. They meet in the fellowship hall on the lower level.

PADS Ministry is our involvement with our local homeless shelter. The fourth Sunday of the month we take a meal and just visit with the individuals at the shelter.

Mentor's Forum is an opportunity for teachers and interested believers to explore practical ways to carry out the Great Commission of making disciples.

Overflow is an informal time of worship for all ages. There is coffee, conversation, song, and testimony of how God works in lives. It is held one Saturday a month at 6:00pm in the multi-purpose room.

IF Gathering 2017 is a simulcast video conference for women. It will be held at OUC in the Multi-Purpose room on Friday, February 3rd from 6pm to 9pm and Saturday, February 4th from 9am to 5pm.

Women at our BEST meets four times a year for women from our church and community to fellowship through song, scripture, and a special speaker. BEST will meet Monday, February 6th from 6:30pm to 8:30pm in the multi-purpose room.

Find Your Spot is a fascinating video study by Chip Ingram. Chip explores passages from the Bible to understand the role of spiritual gifts. In the process, you'll be invited to pinpoint your own primary spiritual gift. Then you will learn the Biblical process to develop and deploy this gift for ministry. This will be held Sundays (Feb 19th & 26th and March 5th & 12) from 4pm to 6pm.
